LEARNING THIS WEEK

Year 1 This week we have been using descriptive language to describe a thunderstorm based on Henri Rousseau’s painting “Tiger in a Tropical Storm”. In Maths, we have been learning about time and practising the days of the week and months of the year. In Art, we have been enjoying the fine weather and creating environmental art out of nature found on the field.

Year 2 have had an incredibly creative week! They’ve been mastering their watercolour skills with beautiful observational paintings of cacti and botanical flowers as part of our Geography work on the diversity and adaptations of plants around the world. They fully embraced our Diversity Day too, participating enthusiastically in an Indian dance workshop and learning part of a song in Portuguese!

Year 3 In Y3 Science, we have begun a new topic about the Skeleton and Nutrition. We have been looking at what the different food groups are; what types of food and drink are healthy choices for us.
