

Learning this week

Year 1 This week we have written the story of the Annunciation and thought about how Mary felt when she heard Angel Gabriel's message. We have also learned that Angel Gabriel said 'Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee.' We then made beautiful pictures of Mary to remember how special she is to us. We decorated our picture frames with glittery sequins. In Maths we have been looking carefully at part, part, whole models to find out what four different number calculations they represent. We have also been learning to subtract by crossing out images in a number representation. In topic we looked at different London landmarks and created London skyline silhouettes for our Van Gogh style 'Starry night' pictures. They are now up in our classrooms and look wonderful!

Year 2 The children in Year two have been exploring diaries and characters further this week. We studied the hilarious 'Unbelievable, Top Secret Diary of Pig' and tried to write the next entry.

Year 3 have begun their new Science Topic - Rocks and Soils. We have started off by looking at a variety of rocks and noticing their differences and similarities. How many different types of rocks and stones do you think we could find in a garden?

Year 4 have been busy writing and performing free-verse poems in English. In RE we have started to explore and understand prophecies from the Old Testament, with a focus on Elijah and Isaiah. In maths are learning how to use column subtraction - next week things will get trickier as we move on to subtraction with an exchange!

Year 5 have learned about the different layers of the rainforest and which animals inhabit them. We have been learning about the different ways plants reproduce and how we could create a clone plant! In maths, we have been linking fractions with division and understanding how our knowledge of times table facts helps us with both of these topics. In English, we have been writing a description of the rainforest. In RE, we studied and explored Psalm 23.

Year 6 have taken a closer look at Miriam's story from the Old Testament. We have considered how she played an important part in Moses' life. We also enjoyed our Parent workshop, during which we looked the physical geographical features of the Lake District. Thank you to all those who attended.
